Hints for creating these pictures – this is how I did it – use it as a guide Feel free to be **Creative** and do you own thing

Note: All drawn items are from Insert - Shapes Remember you can Edit Shapes once they are drawn and adjust the Vector points

Drawing 1:

- Use any clipart or web graphic for Santa
- When you insert the callout, you will have to adjust where the speaking line comes from
- Make sure your callout is big enough (or the words are small enough) to fit

Drawing 2:

- You will have to use the Arrange Bring Forward or Send Backward to put certain things on top of other things
- Try Curve, Freeform or Scribble to draw the tree, the tree skirt and the bows for the presents
- The tree stump, presents and star are Rectangles of Stars
- Use wood texture for the tree stump
- Use any texture you want for the two presents
- Choose any color or gradient fill for the tree and tree skirt
- Insert the ornaments using a circle shape with any fill patterns
- Use a gradient fill for the star

Drawing 3:

- You will have to use the Arrange Bring Forward or Send Backward to put certain things on top of other things
- Try Curve, Freeform or Scribble for the fire
- Use any clipart or web graphic for the Stocking
- The logs on the fire are rectangles with wood textures, rotated
- The fireplace is made up of three rectangles
 - (one white one, one black one, and one with a brick pattern fill)
- Use a gradient fill for the fire
- Add some things to the fireplace mantel if you would like (a clock or something)
- Feel free to add additional ClipArt, such as a picture frame filled with your picture

Drawing 4:


- You will have to use the Arrange Bring Forward or Send Backward to put certain things on top of other things
- For the turkey, draw one feather using the Curve tool for both the outline of the feather and the line inside it
- Give the feather a color and group it (shape and line inside it)
- Copy the feather, rotate and change the fill color
- The body is made of two ovals
- The head is a Scribble drawing, the beak is a rotated triangle, the rooster comb is a Scribble drawing, and the eyeball is a black circle
- Behind his head is a blotch of gray (Scribble draw this)
- The feet are Scribble drawings
